Lake Ashtabula

Located 12 miles north of Valley City, enjoy fishing, boating and skiing, and cabin resort area. This 26 mile lake is maintained by the Corp of Engineers and hosts many camping and recreational spots. Lake Ashtabula is also a trailhead for North Country Trail with 35 miles of certified, groomed trail. Four restaurants, The Crossing, Bayshore Resort, Skippers, and Lee Resort are located on the lake for convenient dining. Pontoons, kayaks, canoes, fishing boats, paddle boats, life jackets and cabins are available to rent from Bayshore Resort.

Hunting and Fishing

There is plenty of hunting variety: mourning doves, deer, sandhill cranes, sharp and roughed-tail grouse, ducks, Canada geese, pheasant, snow geese, fox and coyote. Popular fishing spots are along the Sheyenne River, below dams at Lisbon, Ft Ransom, near Kathryn, Cooperstown, Mill Dam, Bald Hill Dam, Clausen Springs, Hobart Lake, Lake Ashtabula, Moon Lake, St. Mary's Lake and Dead Colt Creek.

Electricity

City of Valley City (701-845-0380):

- Owns and maintains the electric distribution system
- Electrical power purchased from the [Western Area Power Administration](http://www.wapa.gov) (www.wapa.gov) and [Missouri River Energy Services](http://www.mrenergy.com) (www.mrenergy.com)
- Two electric substations with 25 megawatt capacity each
- Peak demand is 20 megawatt with load management
